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Equipment

- The district purchased a new John Deere tractor to replace the 2008 one, and currently owns discs, plow, skid-steer, chipper, no till drill, reg-drill, auger, brush hog, ditcher, broadcaster/fertilizer spreader and rotary tiller. The district rents out the equipment assisting producers with prepping fields, planting, and everyday ranching.
 - Due to Covid-19, the district assisted approximately 17 ranchers maintain their fields and ranches. The district was on stand-by for any ranchers who are in need of assistance to maintain their fields by making an appointment, practicing social distancing, and wearing masks.
